Re: EECBG Round 2 – Areas 2 and 4

Dear Mayor Fincher:

On behalf of Lt. Governor Becky Skillman, we are pleased to notify you that the Office of Energy Development (OED) has selected your application for an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG). A total of **\$257,224** has been approved for activities in Area 2 - Lighting Retrofits for Government-Owned Structures (\$7,224) and 4 - Waste Water Treatment Plants (\$250,000). Please confirm your acceptance via email to John Deahl, EECBG Program Manager, at jdeahl@oed.in.gov, by close of business on Wednesday, May 19th.

In the upcoming weeks, we will provide you with a copy of your grant agreement and relevant financial forms. Once you have returned these documents, the grant agreement will enter the state's signature process. This can take 6-8 weeks for the process to be completed. When the process is complete, the agreement will be fully executed and you will be able to draw down funds. Until then, you are still eligible to incur costs for equipment only.

Please take note that there are some important meetings you should put on your calendar. On June 22nd, Lt. Governor Becky Skillman will host an awards ceremony at the Statehouse. Following the ceremony, OED will host a mandatory orientation meeting to discuss the draw down and reporting process, while also answering any other questions you might have. In addition, you will also be required to attend a separate mandatory meeting to discuss Davis-Bacon wage requirements. There will be four meetings held around the state during the first few weeks of June. An invitation, as well as meeting information, will follow shortly.
